## Important Bulletin From TWU Local 100 President Tony Utano

In response to the rapidly changing developments/instructions from both the Centers for Disease Control, and the State and City of New York (specifically relating to prohibiting meetings/gatherings of more than 50 people), Local 100 will be taking the following actions to address the very serious situation facing our nation:

- Union Meetings are cancelled for the months of March and April.
- Executive Board Meetings are cancelled for the months of March and April.
- All Shop-Gates are cancelled for the months of March and April.
- · Lobby Day is cancelled.
- All other events scheduled to take place at 195 Montague Street are cancelled for March and April.

In cooperation with the MTA, all Step I, Step II and Arbitration calendars are being cancelled except for Pre-Disciplinary Suspension cases. PDS Cases will go forward.

There may be a need for an emergency meeting of Officers and/or Staff, which will be convened on an as needed basis.

The circumstances we face are unprecedented. Local 100 is on the front lines of helping to halt the spread of the Coronavirus – which requires that our members report to work as scheduled. Our first responders and medical providers must have a way to get to their work locations, as public transit is the most reliable way for them to arrive safely both to and from work.
