

Hearing Loss and Transit Workers

Working in transit means you are constantly exposed to a noisy work environment. This can cause a gradual process of hearing loss, called “occupational hearing loss.”

You can file a workers’ compensation claim for such hearing loss within two years AFTER you have been removed from the noisy work environment, for example, after your retirement.
